Contents

The module covers central concepts and methods in the field of phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics/lexicology and pragmatism as well as their application to the Italian. Central issues and methods of historical linguistics as well as important structural elements of the Italian language and Romance Languages in general will be covered, too. Students will learn about the most important linguistic theories. They will acquire central techniques of the academic work (information research as well as preparation and presentation of information) concerning the Romance linguistics.

Students acquire basic skills of Italian and Romance linguistics. They are able to apply the most important linguistic description terms and methods to the Italian language. Students are familiar with basic techniques of scientific work in the area of Romance linguistics.
