Students will learn about Latin stylistic exercises and Latin reading matter for the lower cycle at grammar school; style: special stylistics of word types; specific differences between the Latin and German language: nouns, adjectives, pronouns, verbs, adverbs; Latin syntax; They will translate simple German texts (texts of art and literature) into Latin; They will broaden the active Latin basic vocabulary. Reading matter: Translation of works of a Latin author into appropriate German, which meets the respective genre.

#### **Intended learning outcomes**

Students have knowledge of substantial differences in the use of word classes in the German and Latin language; They are able to apply the respective rules of translation to simple German texts (e.g. texts of art and literature) into Latin; They have a broadened active basic vocabulary; They are able to translate texts of a Latin author into appropriate German, which meets the respective genre.
