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Contents

Students will consolidate their skills concerning the rules of Latin grammar, especially the syntax; They will broaden their Latin phraseology; They will translate German texts of medium difficulty with contents that contain ancient thinking and ideas, into appropriate Latin or classical Latin (retroversions). They will translate Latin literature (prose or poetry) into appropriate German, which meets the respective genre.

Intended learning outcomes

Students are expected to possess in-depth skills of Latin grammar rules, especially concerning the syntax; They are expected to have broadened skills of Latin phraseology; They are able to translate simple German texts and texts of medium difficulty, which contain ancient thinking and ideas, into Latin, which meets the respective or classical Latin (retroversions). They are able to translate texts of Latin literature (prose or poetry) into appropriate German, which meets the respective genre.
